Information

With solo, Bernhard Gal continues his artistic investigation of the perceptual potential and interactions of sound and light environments (for previous works in this realm see a.o. RGB (2001), Klangbojen (2003), or belit (2004)).

The title of this installation does not refer to a solo performer, but to the intimacy of the percipient – four phone booths are turned into such sites, offering an intimate experience within public space. The visitors get confronted with their own perception and awareness, unaffected from their surroundings and other persons.

Each phone booth has a designated colour, for these four light spaces in red, green, blue, and violet Bernhard Gal conceived corresponding musical compositions. The windows of the phone booths are covered with colour and transparency films, resulting in different light and translucency constellations, depending on the time of the day.

solo was realized with used phone booths provided by the Austrian phone company Telekom Austria. The first presentations in Tulln / Gutenbrunn were supported by "Musik aktuell 2007".

4 modified white painted phone booths, neon lights, motion sensors, timers, colour and transparency films, audio playback system, loudspeakers
